Appeals must be made within 6 months of the date given in paragraph 2 above or within 28 days where the application is the same or substantially the same as development that is currently the subject of an enforcement notice. If an enforcement notice is subsequently served relating to such development you must appeal within 28 days of the service of the enforcement notice, or within 6 months of this notice, whichever is the earlier.

Appeals must be made on a form available from the Planning Inspectorate, Room 308a, Kite Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol BS1 6PN. Please note that as this is a householder application, in the event of an appeal against a refusal of planning permission, it will be dealt with on the basis

of representations in writing and any representations made about this application will be sent to the Secretary of State. Objectors will therefore have no further opportunity to comment at appeal stage.
