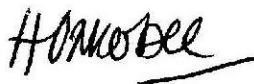

If you want to appeal against the Council's decision you should do so by writing to The Environment Appeals Team, Trees and Hedges, Room 3a Eagle Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The square, Temple Quay, Bristol, BS1 6PN, Telephone: 0303 444 5584 or e-mail: Treeandhedgeappeals@planninginspectorate.gov.uk within 28 days of the date of this letter or such longer period as the Secretary of State may allow.

The appellant shall send to the relevant authority a copy of the notice of appeal, and shall do so at the same time as the appellant gives written notice to the Secretary of State of the tree preservation order appeal or tree replacement notice appeal, as the case may be.

If you suffer any loss or damage as a result of this refusal of consent, or any conditions attached to a consent, you may be entitled to recover compensation from the Council. If you wish to make a claim you must do so within 12 months from the date of this decision or, if you appeal to the Planning Inspectorate, within 12 months from the date of their decision. Claims should be made in writing to the Director of Legal and Governance, London Borough of Havering, Town Hall, Main road, Romford, RM1 3BD.
